- 2. NATURAL ARCH, Nerang-Murwillumbah Road, Springbrook**
Glow worms, picnics, child friendly walks.
- 3. CURRUMBIN CREEK BOARDWALK & BEACH, Currumbin**
Fishing/bike rides/bird watching.
- 4. BILLINGA TO SNAPPER BEACH**
Skate, ride, walk along and daydream a little in the process.
- 5. CURRUMBIN ROCK POOLS, Currumbin creek Rd, Currumbin Valley**
Picnic, swim, discover the creatures in the water and in the bush.
- 6. TALLEBUDGEERA, Gold Coast Highway, Tallebudgeera**
Beach swimming, picnics, dog walking, and kite flying.
- 7. COOMBABAH LAKELANDS CONSERVATION AREA, Brisbane Rd, Coombabah**
Discovery walks for miles.
- 8. BOTANICAL GARDENS ASHMORE, 258 Ashmore Rd, Benowa**
Parks, playgrounds and sensory gardens (and coffee).
